

## AMMENDMENT to the NUNAVIK BELUGA PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Notice is provided on December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019 that the Nunavik Marine Region Wildlife Board (NMRWB) and Eeyou Marine Region Wildlife Board (EMRWB) have made amendments to the Notice of Public Hearing released on November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2019. Updates include the list of Parties to the Hearing, and changes to the submission deadline.

Information presented in the original Public Hearing Notice will remain in effect with the exception of additions or changes listed herein. For greater clarity, if any information in this notice of amendment is in conflict with the originally posted notice, the information in this amendment will apply.

Hearing Dates (unchanged): January 21st – 23rd, 2020

**Location of the Hearing (unchanged):** The hearing will take place in Kuujjuaraapik, Quebec.

Translations are not required for supporting documents, although translated summaries are encouraged. The requirement for translation does not apply to individual Nunavik Inuit.
